Veteran Plate Applications:

Veterans must be recognized as a Veteran, by the Royal Canadian Legion, prior to applying for a Veteran plate. You only have to apply once. Veteran application forms are available from your local SGI Motor Licence Issuer, at www.sgi.sk.ca or by calling the Royal Canadian Legion at 306-525-8739.

How Will the Applicant Receive the Personalized Licence Plate(s)?

After the slogan(s) are reviewed, the personalized licence plate(s) will be manufactured and mailed as per the "Mailing Instructions" on the application.

Before the plate(s) can be displayed on a vehicle you must visit a Motor Licence Issuer to register the plate(s). Driving without registering the plate(s) on your vehicle is subject to a fine.

Applications take 10 business days to process, upon receipt by SGI's Head Office in Regina.

Amateur Radio Licence Plates

Holders of these licence plates must also maintain their Department of Communications authority. If this authority is not maintained, the amateur radio licence plates must be returned to the Auto Fund Division.

Cancellation/Recalls

If SGI receives complaints about a slogan it reserves the right to recall the plate. All complaints must be in writing and will be reviewed by an appeal committee.

Slogans inactive for five (5) years will be offered to the general public for reuse.

Refunds/Cancellations

The fee paid for the special order plate(s) will not be refunded after the plate(s) has/have been manufactured, this also applies to gift applications and returned amateur radio plates.

Leased Vehicles

If the vehicle is leased, the Personlized Licence Plate must be registered in the lessee's name. The lessor's name and address will appear in the secondary name and address field of the registration.

Review of Slogans Selected

If your slogan has been issued to another applicant or the selection can be viewed as unacceptable, the applicant will be notified by phone or in writing and your payment returned. No payment is applied to a Credit Card unless a choice has been approved.

Slogans Cannot Contain:

- Any combination of letters or numbers that conflict with the sequencing currently in use or planned to be used for the Saskatchewan Vehicle Registration System. (examples: ABC 123, 123 ABC, AB 111, 111 AB, ABCD 123, 123 ABCD)
- Any sequencing of "V0000 to 0000V" or "W0000 to 0000W" that are reserved for regular issue Veteran Style Plates.
- Any sequencing of "A0000 to 0000A", "L0000 to 0000L", "M0001 to M9999", "R0000 to 0000R" or "S0000 to 0000S"
- Any sequencing of "A000 to 000A", "L000 to 000L", "M001 to M999", "R000 to 000R", "S000 to 000S", "V000 to 000V" or "W000 to 000W".
- Any combination of characters that may be considered offensive, suggestive or not in good taste.

We cannot approve slogans that imply:

- a) Sexual connotations/slang/advertising
- b) Drug/alcohol connotations
- c) Criminal connotations
- d) General or derogatory slang
- e) Racial/ethnic slang
- f) Political connotations
- Any symbols: Examples: \$! # " " & + ? @ %
 Any combination of characters that may not easily be read by law enforcement (i.e., 11111, B8B8, S5S5)
